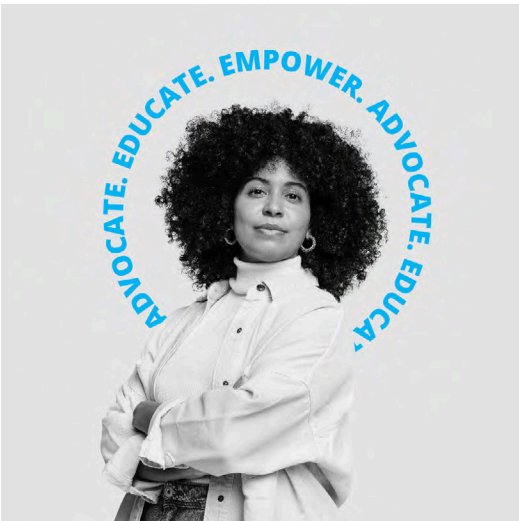

Who is Eligible?

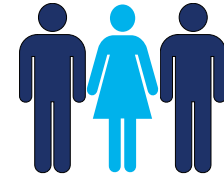
