Boundaries of District A-5 (1985)

Ontario Counties include Algoma (except White River in A-6), Manitoulin and Hompaysne in A-6), Nipissing (except in Temagami A-6) Parry Sound (except Britt and Parry Sound) and Sudbury (except for Gogama in A-6)

Multiple District "A" Map Chronology

- 1920 first clubs included with Michigan until District "A" created for Ontario
- 1922 first Clubs in Quebec and District "A" becomes all of Ontario and Quebec
- 1925 first division into District "A" (Hamilton and all east) District "B" the west only lasts 1 year
- 1931 the first Zones were created designated West, Center, North and East
- 1930's Zones 1-12 were created from West to East (some the same as now)
- 1938 A-1, A-2 and A-3
- 1939 A-4
- 1941 A-5
- 1949 - 1999 A-6
- 1950 - 2002 A-7
- 1953 A-8
- 1958 A-9
- 1961-1994 Labrador City
- 1963 A-10
- 1964 - 2002 A-11
- 1972 A-12, A-14
- 1976 A-15, A-16
- 1982-1994 St Pierre et Miquelon
- 1989 A-17
- 1994 A-8, A-10, A-14 and A-17 become U-1, U-2, U-3, and U-4
- 1999 A-6 absorbed into A-5 and U-1
- 2002 Zone 17-S transferred from A-5 to A-12 to become 21-N
- 2002 Districts A-7 and A-11 merge to become A-711

Boundaries of District A-4 (1985)

Ontario Counties include Renfrew, Lanark, Leeds, Grenville, Dundas, Stormont, Glengarry, Prescott, Russell and the region of Ottawa Carleton.

Quebec Counties include Hull, Gatineau, Papineau, Pontiac (below la Verendrye Park) and Temiscamingue (below highway 62)
